## OECD Guidelines for Multinational Enterprises

The *OECD Guidelines for Multinational Enterprises* are recommendations for international business conduct in such areas as labour, environment, consumer protection and the fight against corruption. In the five years since their inception, the *Guidelines* have consolidated their position as one of the world's principal instruments in the field of corporate responsibility. The *Annual Report on the OECD Guidelines for Multinational Enterprises* includes the full text of the *Guidelines* plus updates and special focuses on adhering countries' experiences in implementation.

## OECD Principles of Corporate Governance

Since they were first issued in 1999, the *OECD Principles of Corporate Governance* have gained worldwide recognition as an international benchmark for good corporate governance. They are actively used by governments, regulators, investors, corporations and stakeholders in both OECD and non-OECD countries and have been adopted by the Financial Stability Forum as one of the Twelve Key Standards for Sound Financial Systems. The current version was revised in 2004 to take into account developments since 1999 and includes several important amendments.

## OECD E-Government Studies

The spread of new information and communication technologies has spurred major changes at all levels of society, and notably in citizen expectations. The implications for government are wide-ranging and transition to e-government presents many opportunities to improve the function of public administration and its relationship to the public. However, without coherent and effective strategies, these opportunities are unlikely to be exploited to their full potential. This book series examines in depth the issues and challenges raised by e-government, including both general overview reports, along with case studies of individual country experiences.

## OECD Reviews of Regulatory Reform

These reviews present an integrated assessment of regulatory reform in framework areas such as the quality of the public sector, competition policy and enforcement, and market openness. They also contain chapters on sectors such as telecommunications, electricity, road and rail freight, and an assessment of the macroeconomic context for reform. The policy recommendations present a balanced plan of action for both the short and long term.

## China in the Global Economy

The rapid economic growth of China and its integration into the world economy have been nothing short of remarkable. However, without improved governance, this growth may prove unsustainable. In addition, many serious problems such as social unrest, mass urban migration and corruption will not be solved by economic growth alone. This book series provides analysis and recommendations on a variety of China's governance and economic policy issues, based on ongoing cooperation and dialogue between Chinese policy makers and the OECD.



## Fighting Corruption in Transition Economies

This book series presents the results of peer reviews of various transition economies' efforts to fight corruption. Each country review examines national anti-corruption policy and institutions currently in place, national anti-corruption legislation, and preventative measures to ensure the integrity of civil service and effective financial control.

It examines certain selected key public management policy levers of reform such as: making government more responsive, transparent and accessible; instilling a performance approach in the public sector; changing accountability and control systems; facilitating reallocation and restructuring; organising and motivating public servants; and integrating a market approach.
