## STAN: Structural Analysis Statistics

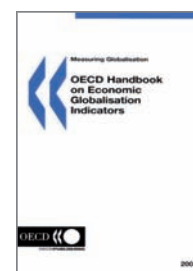


The *STAN* online database provides analysts and researchers with a comprehensive tool for analysing industrial performance at a detailed level of activity across countries. It includes five component databases: *Industry*; *Bilateral Trade*; *Research and Development Expenditure in Industry (ANBERD)*; *STAN Indicators*; and *Input/Output Tables*. Together, these data allow users to construct a wide range of indicators for such areas as productivity growth, competitiveness and general structural change. *R&D Expenditure in Industry* is also available as a publication.

## Iron and Steel Industry Statistics



*Iron and Steel Industry Statistics* are available as a publication and an online database. Data covers steel production, consumption and trade data, as well as indicators of activity such as employment levels, annual investment expenditures by sector and by country, export prices, domestic prices and indices for certain iron and steel products. Coverage is provided for OECD countries and Brazil, Bulgaria, India, Romania, Russia and Ukraine.



## Measuring Globalisation Statistics



Globalisation as an abstract concept is familiar to everyone; yet collecting and developing indicators for empirical analysis of this phenomenon remains a challenge. *Measuring Globalisation Statistics* are the result of the pioneering work of the OECD in this field. *OECD Economic Globalisation Indicators* are available as a publication and an online database. The indicators help identify economic activities in OECD countries that are under foreign control, and their contribution to growth, employment, productivity, labour compensation, R&D, technology diffusion and international trade. These statistics help to gauge the intensity and magnitude of the globalisation process, and shed new light on financial, technological and trade interdependencies among OECD countries. In addition, the manual *OECD Handbook on Economic Globalisation Indicators* defines concepts and puts forward guidelines for data collection and fine-tuning of globalisation indicators based on the experience of the OECD in this area.

## Statistics on International Trade in Services



*OECD Statistics on International Trade in Services* presents both detailed and summary data on international trade in services, by type of service and by partner country. The information is presented for the 30 OECD member countries as well as selected non-member countries such as China and Hong Kong. Comparable zone totals are provided for the euro area, G7, NAFTA, OECD-Asia and Pacific, OECD-Europe and OECD total. The statistics are available in an online database, on CD-ROM, or in an annual 2-volume publication.

## Structural and Demographic Business Statistics



Covering all OECD countries, *Structural and Demographic Business Statistics* provides official annual data for the period 1996-2003 for industrial and service sectors and for the following variables: production, value added, investment, employment, wages, hours worked, and number of establishments. It also provides unique business demographic statistics, describing birth and death rates of enterprises and presenting information on business establishments by size. The data are available as a publication and an online database.



## Enhancing the Performance of the Services Sector

The services sector now accounts for over 70% of employment and value added in OECD economies and for almost all employment growth in the OECD area. But productivity growth in services remains low. This report provides an overview of the role of services in economic performance, and the factors that affect services sector performance including the role of labour and product markets, the impact of barriers to trade in services, the role of innovation and the impacts of ICT.
